

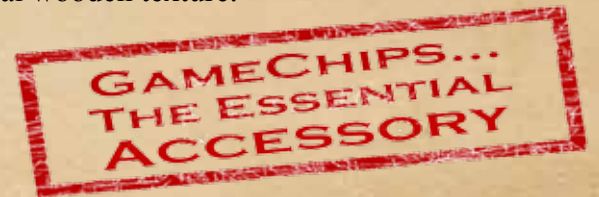
A great number of popular board games use some form of currency as a core part of their design. Games from *Monopoly* to *Power Grid* use paper money. Games

What are GameChips?

GameKnight's **GameChips** are a great solution for gamers who demand the best. Our **GameChips** are created from high quality ceramic poker chips that have been adapted to meet the needs of board gamers. The graphic design follows a natural progression of materials including wood, brick, and stone designs for the low-value chips (1\2\3). The middle range of chips are bronze, silver, and gold (5\10\20), followed by paper currency designs for 25\50\100. The upper values use a variety of gem designs. For *7 Wonders*, all you have to do is trade in your cardboard counters for the **GameChips** listed below. For example, instead of using 30 1-value cardboard tokens, you would use 30 ceramic poker chips printed with GameKnight's special wooden texture.
